Upload a poster in PowerPoint or PDF online. It will be checked and then printed on high-quality paper before being shipped to Stockholm. You can collect it on-site.

## STEP 1: Prepare your poster in PowerPoint or PDF, 134 x 90 cm landscape, 1 slide only

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

What is the cost of the service?

- the **PrintingOnline and delivery** service costs **59€ + VAT**. Collect it on-site at the poster desk in the Speaker's Service Center.

What is the production quality of the poster produced?

- The poster is available with 4 colour printing on 200g/m<sup>2</sup> photographic paper.
- Poster size 134 x 90 cm landscape.

How will the poster be checked?


- The layout (but not scientific content) is checked via 6 quality control assessments assuring 100% accuracy.

What consideration has been made with respect to referencing?

- All posters will be given a Digital Object Identifier number (DOI), similar to the ISBN number for books. It allows referencing in future work including abstracts, CVs, journals etc.


When is the deadline? The deadline for submitting a poster is **2nd April 2014 (23:59 Central European Time)**.

## Correct dimensions



A common mistake in posters we receive is incorrect dimensions. This can cause distortion to the final format for printing.

These are the correct poster dimensions:



134cm  
90cm
